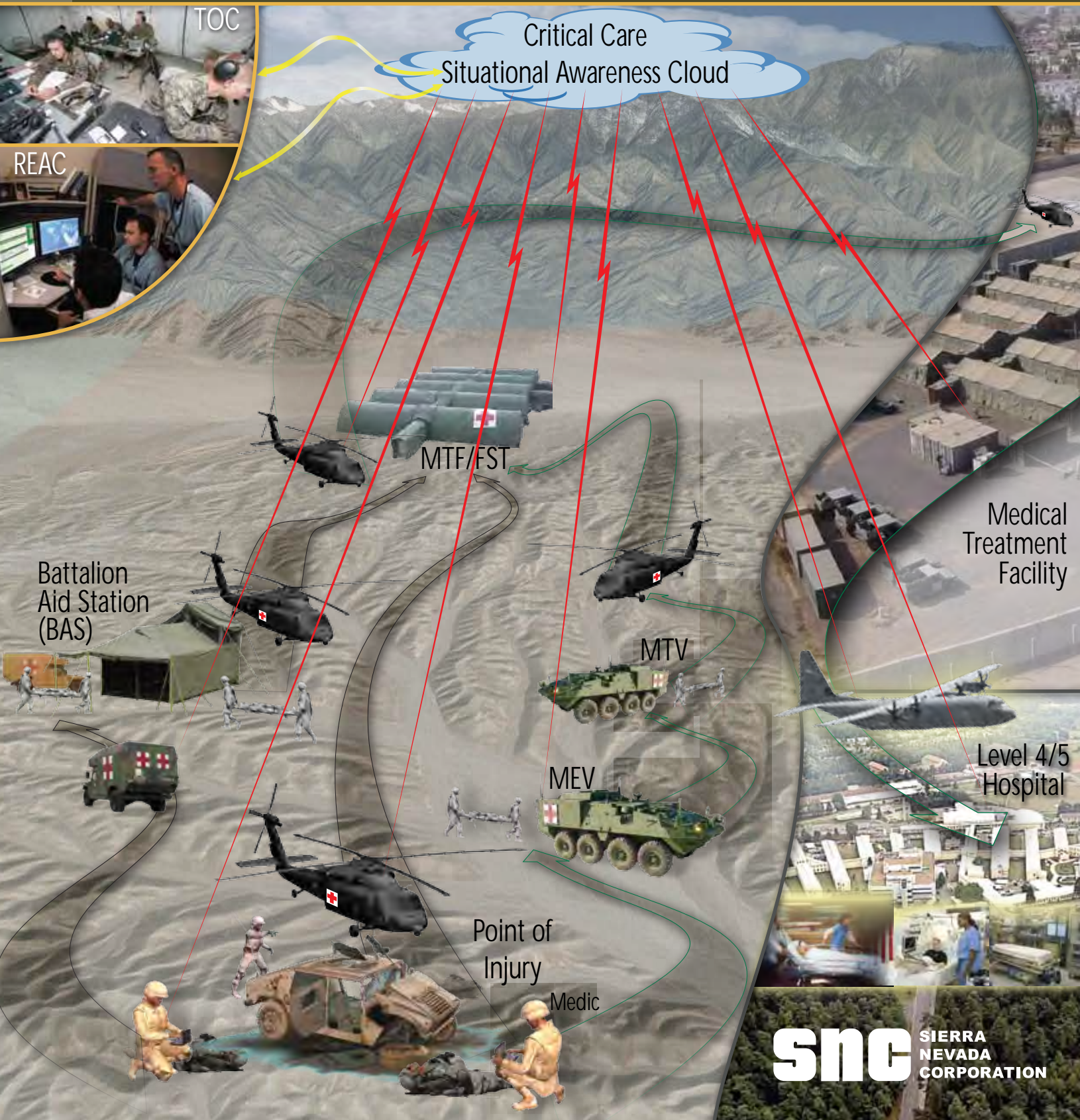

Improved Survivability in 3 Degrees

1st Degree: Point of Care

- Improved data capture
- Reduced workload
- Decision assistance
- Voice data entry
- Remote expert assistance

2nd Degree: CCSA

- Real-time data flow
- Facility preparation
- Reduced time to surgery
- Global Critical Care SA
- Command & Control visibility

3rd Degree: Longitudinal

- Significant data for research
- Improved patient medical record
- Real-time data into DoD databases



MEDICS

Medical and Emergency Data Input and Communications Software

- Syncs data to patient Information Carrier
- GUI adaptable to provider level of ability
- External resources customer specific: formularies, protocols, calculators, etc...
- Capture data from entire spectrum of devices
- Data capture and transmission rates configurable
- Allows medic to 'request' remote assistance
- Communication status indicators
- Decision assist in development
- Patient vitals always visible
- Voice data entry
